



Student Counselor Job description

Essential Responsibilities:

- Attend auditions and provide support to the Director by checking in participants and sitting at the audition table, if asked.
- Attend ALL rehearsals and performances.
- Provide DIRECT support to the students through learning all of their choreography and vocal parts.
- If and when free time arises, spend that time engaging with the students by playing theater games or reviewing their music/choreo/blocking.
- Be a role model and mentor to students, modeling positive behavior and constructive participation in all activities.
- Be sure to keep a professional and mature attitude with the students by
 - Keeping sensitive information shared in staff meetings and the audition room confidential
 - Encouraging friendly behavior between students at all times
 - Putting an immediate stop to rumor spreading or unfriendly behavior of any kind.
- Identify and respond to camper behavior issues. Report major concerns or issues to the Director at an appropriate time.
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety guidelines associated with the program. This includes but is not limited to being responsible for students whereabouts **at all times**.
- Assist in the clean up after all rehearsals and performances, while encouraging students to clean up after themselves.
- During technical rehearsals and performances, remain ATTENTIVE and ALERT backstage with the students. Keep them quiet and alert to what is happening on stage.
- Act as stage crew during rehearsals and performances when needed.
- Have respect and deference for the leadership and vision of the Director, with an understanding that the entire vision and trajectory of the show is under her control.
- Be self directed: to do your work without constant supervision and guidance.
- Speak up and assert your ideas respectfully and at the appropriate time.
- Notice when something needs done or someone needs help and jump in without being asked.
